Week of August 10th — Matthew 14:22-23

Faith Reflection: Jesus fed the multitudes and goes up a mountain to pray while sending the disciples out in a boat. The wind whips up the sea in the middle of the night and Jesus looks like a ghost as he miraculously walks on the water toward his disciples. They aren't afraid once Jesus speaks to them and the ever-eager Peter asks to walk out to the Lord. Peter's walk lasts as long as his faith is strong and his courage holds up. 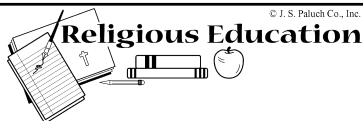

OUR PARISH FINANCES

Many thanks to all for your generous contribution to our Church in the Offertory Collection each Sunday. Here is the report for the Offertory Collection on Sunday, July 19/20th:

Envelopes and Plate Collection	\$3,891
<u>Restricted Donation</u>	<u>\$250</u>
Total	\$4,141

Your generosity in the summer months is very important to the Church as our Sunday collections go down with many people out of town. We invite larger donations from parishioners and friends who can do so. Your generous contributions fund all the parish worship, religious, educational and service programs of the parish. Many thanks and God's blessings on you and your family.



Work continues on some major renovation projects this summer:

1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School is now almost complete. Cost estimate: \$35,000 in labor plus costs of materials.
2. Renovating the school offices, administration and faculty area of the school is nearing completion. Cost estimate: \$30,000
3. We hope to receive a County permit this week to begin repairing and renovating the men's restroom in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the women's restroom in the Parish Hall will also be replaced. This means that both restrooms will be accessible to people in wheel chairs. Cost estimate: \$25,000.
4. Heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory for the Pastor's Office and Fr. O'Sullivan's room are complete. Cost: \$6,905.
5. We hope work will take place this week on repairing and replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost: \$10,380.

We are very grateful to four parish families who have donated \$14,711 to fund these projects. Any gifts or donations would be helpful in meeting the many needs for maintaining and renovating our Church and school buildings.

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 10th

"Take courage it is I; do not be afraid" are the comforting words of Jesus to the disciples being tossed about in the stormy sea in today's Gospel (Matthew 14:22ff.) The power of Jesus over wind and sea leads the disciples to acclaim Jesus as the Son of God. In times of doubt, turmoil, problems, Jesus is present to us also especially as we are gathered together like the disciples in the boat (a symbol for the Church). At times we may feel that we ourselves and the boat may be sinking and may cry out like Peter: "Lord, save me!" What is certain is the presence of Jesus. We may be surprised, just as Elijah is surprised (in today's First Reading from 1 Kings 19:9ff.) Elijah is surprised to find the presence of God not in a strong heavy wind or earthquake or fire but in a tiny whispering sound. May we recognize God's presence in the storms of life and as he comes to us in gentleness and love to calm our doubts and fears and lead us forward to peace and life.

- Next Sunday at all Masses Father Steve, our Pastor, and Chris Toomey will make an appeal for the "Adopt-A-Student" Program at Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. Many thanks to many parishioners and friends for the wonderful response to the Appeal on August 11 last year. \$121,500 was donated to the Adopt-A-Student Appeal which helped 36 families and 45 children with their tuition so they could attend our wonderful parish school here at Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

For the new school year our parish school is providing a total of \$126,000 in tuition assistance to families. You can help by making a donation or pledge to Adopt-A-Student today. Your gift could cover the weekly cost of \$145, the monthly cost of \$550, or the full \$5,510 to educate a child for the entire year. A larger donation or gift in your will would be a gift that keeps giving. Everyone on our parish mailing list will receive a letter on the Adopt-A-Student Program this week and materials will be available in Church next Sunday. Your generous response is very much appreciated.

On this feast day as Catholics we celebrate our belief that the Blessed Virgin Mary, having finished her life on earth, was taken up body and soul into heaven. She is the first Christian to share fully in the Easter life of the Risen Christ. Where she is, we hope to be, some day in God's love.

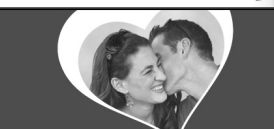
