Faith Reflection: In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells the disciples of the suffering and death he faces, although he does mention that he will be raised on the third day. This revelation understandably disturbs Peter who declares, "No such thing shall ever happen to you." Peter and the other disciples to not know that Jesus is not a conquering messiah; he is a messiah who will save through sacrifice on the cross. Jesus corrects Peter and explains that in order to be a true follower, all must deny themselves and take up their own cross. **Faith Question:** What is the cross that I carry right now and how can I show that I am willing to carry it? Faith Response: This week I will reflect on Jesus' words, "What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?"



OUR PARISH FINANCES

Many thanks to all for your generous contributions to our Church in the Offertory Collection each Sunday. Here is the report for the Offertory Collection on Sunday, August 9th/10th:

Your generosity in the summer months is very important to the Church as our Sunday collections go down with many people out of town. We invite larger donations from parishioners and friends who can do so. Your generous contributions fund all the parish worship, religious, educational and service programs of the parish. UPDATE ON MAJOR RENOVATION PROJECTS THIS SUMMER

1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School is now completed. Cost: \$35,000 in labor plus materials.

- 2. The renovation of the school offices, administrative and faculty area of the School is now complete. Cost: \$30,000 (plus extra costs for major electrical work ~ \$6,000)
- 3. We hope to receive a County permit this week to work on the repair and renovation of the men's rest room in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the women's restroom in the Parish Hall will also be replaced so both restrooms will be wheelchair accessible. Cost estimate: \$25,000.
- 4. Heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory are complete. Cost: \$6,905.
- 5. Work has begun on repairing and replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost estimate: now \$12,670 because of the need to replace the awning over the Parish Hall.

We are very grateful to four parish families who have donated \$14,711 to fund these projects. Any gifts or donations would be helpful in maintaining and renovating our Church and School buildings.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus speaks of going to face a Cross in Jerusalem in today's Gospel (Matthew 16:21-27), a Cross that leads to Resurrection on the third day. Jesus also tells us that as Christians we too will face the Cross. It cannot be avoided in life but it is a Cross that leads to glory and new life, now and hereafter. All three Readings of today's Eucharist speak the same message: about the suffering and sacrifice that cannot be avoided by those who follow God's way, the way of love. Yet our religion is not a life of misery but a life of love and joy in following Jesus where we are "transformed by the renewal of our mind, that we may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect" (as St. Paul tells us today in Romans 12:1-2).
