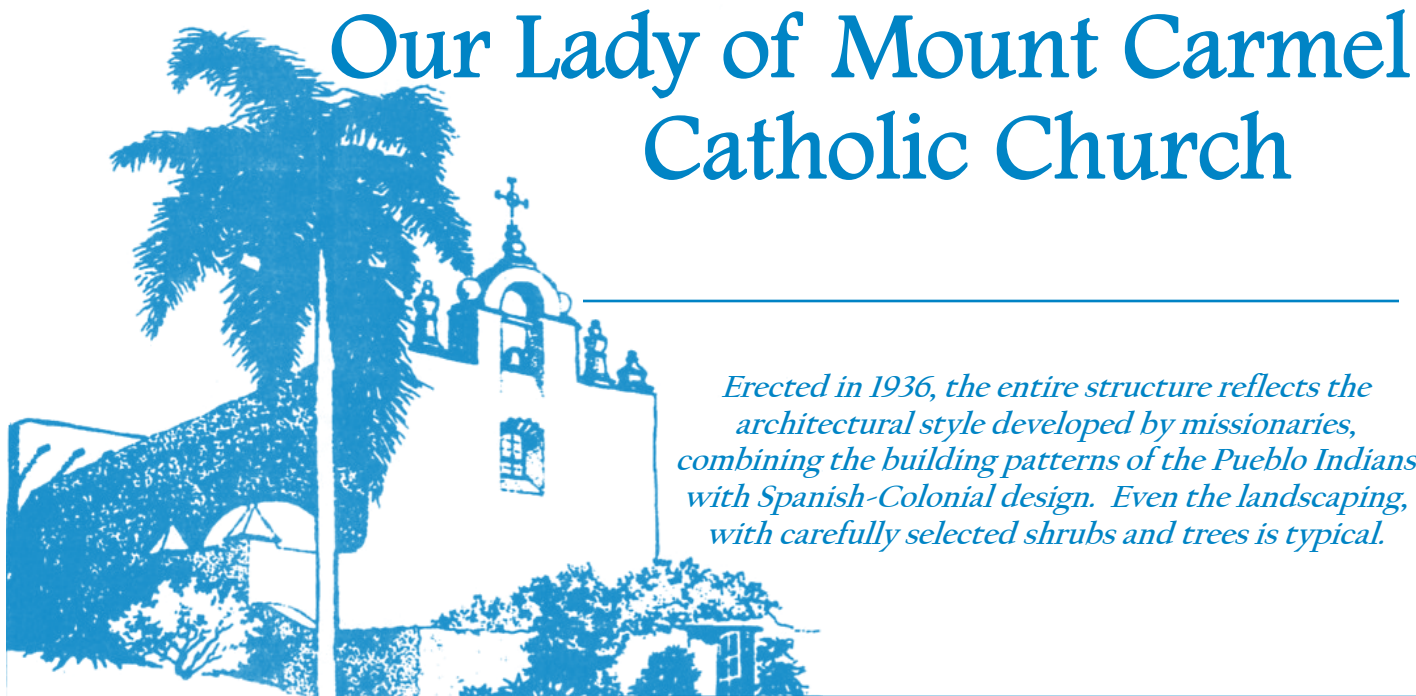




Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church

- ♥ medicine cabinet/first aid items — aspirin, cough syrup, children's Tylenol, band-aids

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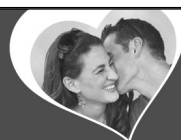
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
