"Be my Valentine" has been a popular phrase this weekend as many exchange Valentines to express love and caring for the special person or people in our lives. In the Gospel we see Jesus expressing God's love and caring for each person, even for the person most outcast in society like the leper in today's Gospel (Mark 1:40ff). Jesus reaches out and touches and heals the man with leprosy, a dreadful disease at the time of Jesus. Jesus comes with compassion and healing. To each person Jesus says: "you are special in God's eyes. Be at peace. Be healed. Walk in love." St. Paul encourages us to have the same love and goodness to others in today's Second Reading (1 Corinthians 10:31ff): "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ....whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God. Avoid giving offense....just as I try to please everyone in every way..." Jesus shows us the way of love, compassion, caring - the way of a true Valentine.

Safeguard Our Children Help Prevent Child Victimization

Many assume that children at risk for victimization are neglected or from dysfunctional homes. However, all children, even those from supportive families, may be at risk of victimization. Encourage your child to come to you immediately if anyone makes him or her feel uncomfortable online or makes overtures to meet in person. These are some signs an online predator may be connecting with your child: Your child becomes withdrawn and isolated from family and friends; you find inappropriate material on the computer; your child receives mail, money, or gifts from unknown people; you see unknown phone numbers when reviewing the phone bill.


Here is the report for the Offertory Collection on Sunday, January 24th/25th:
