WHOLE COMMUNITY FAITH SHARING Week of July 13th — Matthew 13:1-13

Faith Reflection: The Gospel and the First Reading from the Book of Isaiah tell the parable of the seed planted in different conditions. The parable is the same in both books of the Bible, but Jesus explains more deeply. He tells the disciples how fortunate they are to be able to truly hear the message and act upon it. They are the seeds that yield a hundred fold. The fate of the other "seeds" (people hearing the Word of God) are not so fortunate. We need to look into our hearts and see where our seed has fallen.

Faith Question: What am I doing to help the seeds of my faith grow each day?

Faith Response: I will read this gospel over each day this week and figure out a way to show I am the seed on fertile soil.

FR. STEVE

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus, the Great Story Teller, begins a sermon in parables today (Matthew 13:1-23). A parable is a short story drawn from daily life and experience which Jesus uses to make us think and be open to his preaching, be open to the Word of God. In today's Parable of the Sower and the Seed, we first hear that the Seed is the Word of God's Kingdom sown in all kinds of soils with different reactions and results. What kind of soil are we? Are we open and receptive, taking to heart God's powerful Word of life, love and justice? As God's Word sinks into the depths of open hearts and minds, a great harvest comes, 30 or 60 or 100 times as much as was planted a harvest of love and goodness and life. Are our eyes open to see, our ears open to hear, our hearts open to receive God's Word today?

- Father Steve, our Pastor, is away on his annual vacation. He will return to Our Lady of Mount Carmel on July 20th.
- We are blessed to have Father Liam O'Connell, S.J., with us to minister in the parish until his return to Ireland on July 28th. Father Liam is the cousin of Father Maurice O'Mahony, our Pastor Emeritus
- Work has begun on some major renovation projects this summer:
- 1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. Cost: \$35,500 in labor, plus cost of materials.
- 2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School. Cost estimate: \$20,000
- 3. Repairing and renovating the Men's Rest Room in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the Women's Rest Room in the Parish Hall will also be replaced. This means that both Rest Rooms will be accessible to people in wheel chairs. Cost estimate: \$25,000.
- 4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory for the Pastor's Office and Fr. O'Sullivan's room. Cost: \$6,905
- 5. Repairing /replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost: \$10,380.
