School is out and it is time for young people to go outside, be active, have fun and make new friends. In the summer months, predators will also be outside & active--driving around the neighborhoods and hanging out at the parks.

Encourage your kids to stay with a group. Tell your kids to trust their instincts. If they think something isn't right or they feel uncomfortable about a situation they should leave and tell an adult. Warn your children not to fall for common lures such as "I need help finding a lost dog,"

Tell them to keep an eye out for suspicious activity around them such as a car slowing down, circling or stopping near them or if they see someone unusual hanging around the area. Tell them to run to a public place and have someone call the police. Knowledge, caution and alertness are our children's best protection.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

FR. STEVE

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JULY 6, 2014

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" are the comforting words of Jesus in today's passage from Matthew 11:25~30. This has been called "The Great Invitation". It is an invitation for a "closer walk with Jesus" as we face the burdens of life. Jesus has been called "our fellow sufferer and companion, the one who understands." Can we trust in his love and presence with us? Can we accept the words of the First Reading (from Zechariah 9:9~10): "Rejoice, heartily, O daughter Zion...See, your king shall come to you, a just savior is he"? St. Paul reminds us in the Second Reading (Romans 8:9, 11~13) that we are "in the spirit". He calls us to let God's Spirit of love dwell in us so that we can come to life and be filled with God's love. What great messages of grace, strength, refreshing peace we hear in today's Eucharist!

- Father Steve, our Pastor, is away on his annual vacation. He will return to Our Lady of Mount Carmel on July 20th.
- We are blessed to have Father Liam O'Connell, S.J., with us to minister in the parish until his return to Ireland on July 28th. Father Liam is the cousin of Father Maurice O'Mahony, our Pastor Emeritus
- Work has begun on some major renovation projects this summer:
- 1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. Cost: \$35,500 in labor, plus cost of materials.
- 2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School. Cost estimate: \$20,000
- 3. Repairing and renovating the Men's Rest Room in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the Women's Rest Room in the Parish Hall will also be replaced. This means that both Rest Rooms will be accessible to people in wheel chairs. Cost estimate: \$25,000.
- 4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory for the Pastor's Office and Fr. O'Sullivan's room. Cost: \$6,905
- 5. Repairing /replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost: \$10,380.

We invite donations from generous parishioners and friends for any of these repairs/renovations. Any gifts or donations would be helpful in meeting the many needs for maintaining and renovation our Church and School buildings.
