Of course this sounds preposterous to his listeners, but Jesus knows of their doubts and repeats in no uncertain terms that they must partake of this holy body and blood in order to live. This Eucharist, the sharing of Jesus' body and blood is at the very center of our faith.





THE FEAST OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (the Feast of Corpus Christi). This feast began in 1261 as a way of showing great reverence and love for Christ present in a special way in the Eucharist. In the First Reading of today's Mass (from Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16), Moses tells the Israelites: Remember how God was always faithful to you in your wanderings and how he fed you with manna, a food for the journey in the desert. The Eucharist is our "Food for the Journey to Heaven" that began at Baptism. St. Paul tells us in the Second Reading (from 1 Corinthians 10:16-17) that by sharing in the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist "we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." In Holy Communion we are one with the Lord and with each other in love. In the Gospel (John 6:51-58) Jesus says: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven...and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the world...whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day..." As we receive Jesus in Holy Communion or adore his Real Presence in the Eucharist in the Tabernacle, may our hearts be filled with love and thanksgiving.

- The annual commissioning ceremony for Eucharistic Ministers will take place after the homily at each Mass this Sunday. We are blessed to have many parishioners serving in this "great ministry of love" (in the words of Pope Paul VI). If you are interested in being a Eucharistic Minister at Mass on Sunday or in bringing Holy Communion to the sick or shut-ins at home or in nursing homes, please contact our Pastor, Father Steve.

- We welcome to our parish later this week Fr. Liam O'Connell, S.J., the cousin of Father Maurice O'Mahony, our Pastor Emeritus. Father Liam has come to serve at Mount Carmel each summer for the last sixteen years. He will be with us until July 28th.

- On Saturday, June 28th, Father Steve will leave on his annual vacation. He will return to Our Lady of Mount Carmel on July 28th.

- Plans are being made for some major renovation work this summer:

1. Painting the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School on the outside

2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School

3. Repairing and renovating the rest rooms in the Parish Hall

4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory
