

The Most Holy Trinity MAY 31, 2015



Who is God? On this Trinity Sunday we celebrate our Catholic answer to this question. The answer comes from our belief that the one God reveals himself to us in Jesus as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The First Reading today from Deuteronomy 4:32ff calls us to remember what great things God has done for the chosen people of Israel (and for our people too): "This is why you must now know, and fix in your heart, that the Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other." There is one God, the Lord of all. Yet in the New Testament we learn more. St. Paul tells us in the Second Reading (Romans 8:14~ 17) that led by the Spirit of God we are children of God and heirs with Christ and can cry out to God the Father: "Abba, Father". In Matthew's Gospel (28:16-20) Jesus sends his disciples (and ourselves) on a mission to teach and share the good news of God's love for all and to baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Today we celebrate God as Father giving us life and loving us so much that he sends his Son, Jesus, as our Savior. From Father and Son comes the Holy Spirit of love, peace and unity. How great is God's love for all!


