Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish Coronavirus Weekly Update as of May 26, 2020 at 10:00 am

Dear Parishioners & Friends,

Praise the Lord. The county of Santa Barbara and the Archdiocese are now allowing the churches to reopen. The Archdiocese says we can open for Sunday Mass beginning the weekend of June 7^{th.} It is extremely important that we open the church in a very safe manner. The reality is that Church will not be like it was before the virus. I have met with the Pastoral Council and the parish staff, and we are working out how we can celebrate the liturgy in our church given the many safety restrictions the County is asking for. It is recommended that that those who are more vulnerable to the virus, those 65 and older or who have compromised immune system, should still not attend Mass at this time. They should continue to watch our livestream of the Mass. The Archbishop has indefinitely dispensed the Sunday Obligation of attending Mass.

In planning for attendance at a Mass inside our church, we will be allowed to have 25% of the church's capacity to allow for social distancing. Therefore, for the first few weekends, we may require an advanced reservation to attend Mass. We are still working out the details and I will send out more information next week.

For Confession, we are not staring up with the regularly scheduled Saturday time. However, please call the office or send me an email and we can schedule a time for me to hear your confession outside. We both will be required to wear a mask.

Here are some activities that you should know about. Bishop Barron will preside at two outdoor prayer services on Pentecost Sunday:

10:30 am at St. Louis de Monfort, Santa Maria 2 pm at St. Joseph's Church, Carpinteria

It will be a brief car service (approximately 30 minutes), consisting of an opening prayer, a reading, the Gospel, homily, followed by 15 minutes of Eucharistic Adoration and close with Benediction. Please note that while this is an outdoor event, everyone will be asked to remain in their cars to ensure safe distancing.
