As you know, we continue to distribute Communion at 11:10 am in the parking lot, for those who are watching the livestream Mass, or who for safety reasons, it is recommended that they not come to Mass in person. We have noticed that there is a bottle neck in the parking lot where we give out Communion, so to make it easier, we are going to move the location of Communion to the side courtyard, on Hot Springs Road. Just pull up in your car, and we will show you where to go.
