Dear Parishioners,

We hope you are all doing well! We first want to say 'Thank You' for your dedication to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. This past year has shown how strong, resilient, and faithful our parish community is. It is great that better days have come our way in the fight against the pandemic and we look forward to continued movement in a positive direction.

We are happy to share that we received a letter and updated Liturgical guidelines from Archbishop Gomez. In his letter he shares,

"The coronavirus pandemic has affected our world and society in ways we could have never imagined. We remain strong in our faith that God will always be by our side.

And so, on June 19th and 20th, I encourage the Catholic faithful of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to return to in-person Sunday Mass and the celebration of the Sacraments, especially those who are in good health.

Effective June 19, 2021, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation in response to the coronavirus pandemic will be lifted for the Catholic faithful of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles."

All liturgical celebrations (e.g., Weekday Masses, Sunday Masses, First Communions, Confirmation, Weddings, Baptisms, Funerals, Quinceañeras) and other religious services (e.g., Private Prayer, Adoration, Devotions, Prayer Services) are allowed to take place indoors without capacity limitations, social distancing, and/or prearranged "reservation" systems.

Masks are not required for fully vaccinated individuals outdoors or indoors for religious services.

Masks are required for unvaccinated individuals outdoors when social distancing is not possible, and at all times indoors.
